**Sub:** Grant of conditional permission to the Shiv Shakti Ayurvedic college, Sunam Road, Bhikhi, Distt.- Mansa-151504, Punjab with 60 seats in BAMS (UG) course and under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18 - reg.

Sir/Madam

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.12011/24/2013-EP(IM-1) for 2016-17 dated 09.12.2016 related to admission matter for the year 2016-17 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2017-18.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 17-18.04.2017 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to this Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the college was not having required number of eligible teachers, required number of higher faculty in required number of departments, required number of hospital staffs etc. as per RSM. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 11.08.2017 to present the case.

3. The recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM and observation of Hearing Committee based on the submissions made by the college during hearing have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017 and it has been decided by the Central Government to grant of conditional permission to Shiv Shakti Ayurvedic college, Sunam Road, Bhikhi, Distt.- Mansa-151504, Punjab for 60 seats in BAMS (UG) course for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill



the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19.

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 by 31st December 2017 to get conditional permission or permission for a period of five years
  - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
  - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
4. The fulfillment of the deficiencies pointed out (if any) in the enclosed assessment report of the CCIM and the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2018-19.
5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.


